## ANDRE LOGAN SR DIRECTOR GREAT LAKES NATIONAL CEMETERY HOLLY, MICHIGAN

Mr. Logan was named Director of Great Lakes National Cemetery effective May 21, 2023. In this role, he is responsible for all burial, maintenance, and administrative operations of the cemetery. In addition, Mr. Logan will oversee operations for Fort Mackinac Post Cemetery located on Mackinac Island, MI and Lakeside Soldiers Lot located in Port Huron, MI.



Mr. Logan previously served as the Director of Fort Custer National Cemetery from May 2022 to April 2023. In addition, he is a 2022 graduate of the Cemetery Director Development Program (CDDP). The CDDP is a year long comprehensive training program designed to develop future Cemetery Directors for the National Cemetery Administration (NCA). Mr. Logan served at Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery where he completed classroom and hands-on training emphasizing leadership, business acumen, and field operations.

Prior to this assignment, Mr. Logan served as the Management Analyst at Indiantown Gap National Cemetery in Annville, Pennsylvania, from May 2016 to 2021. There, he was responsible for the cemetery's budget, contracts, and assisting the Director with the execution of the approved annual financial plan and cemetery operations. Mr. Logan previously served as a Cemetery Representative. Mr. Logan joined NCA in January 2016 as a Term Caretaker at Culpeper National Cemetery in Virginia. He also served on the Organizational Assessment and Improvement Program in 2017 and 2018.

Mr. Logan is a Veteran who served 15 years in the U.S. Army as an Engineer and Paratrooper. He deployed multiple times in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom
